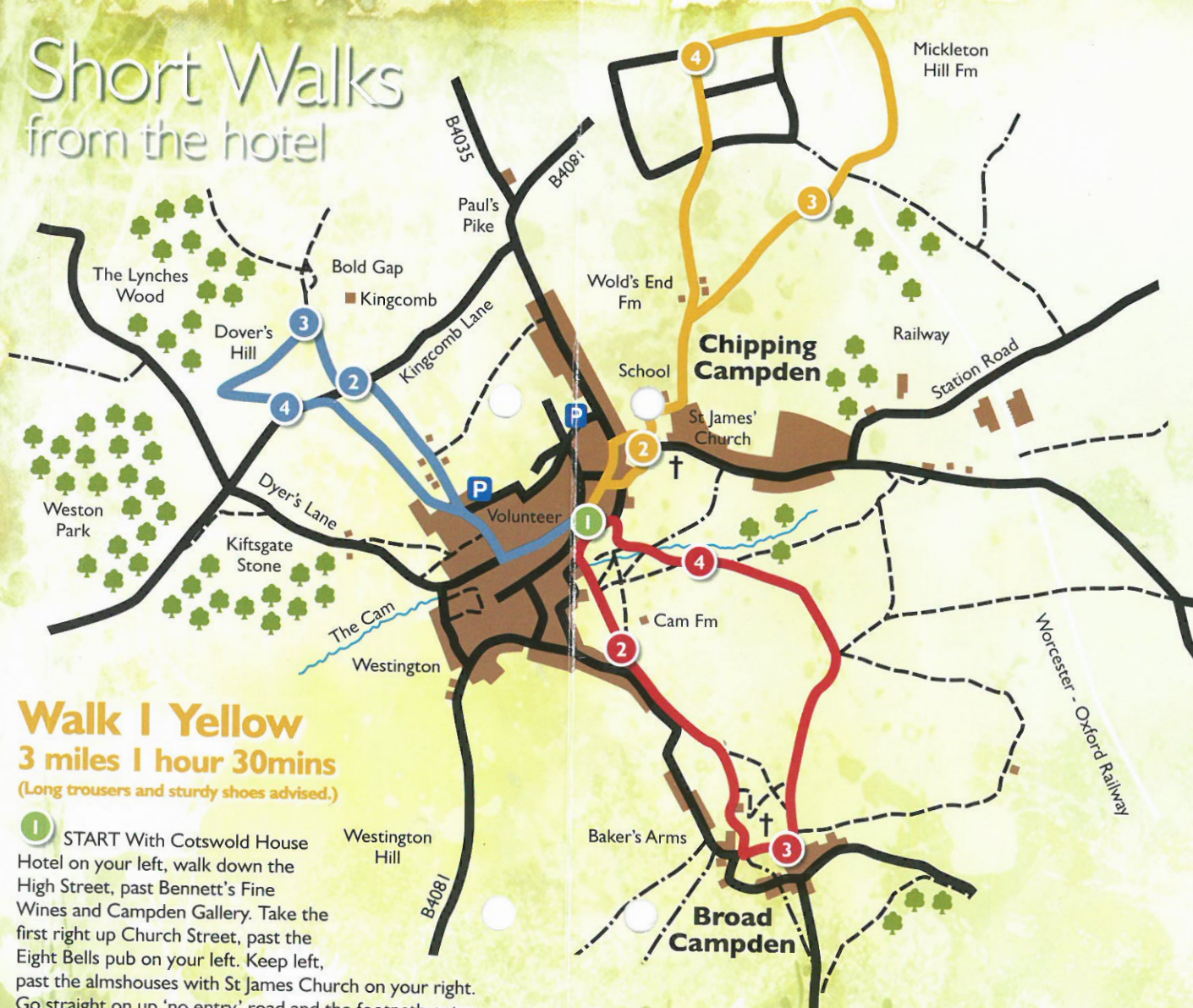


Short Walks from the hotel



Walk 1 Yellow 3 miles 1 hour 30mins (Long trousers and sturdy shoes advised.)

- 1 START With Cotswold House Hotel on your left, walk down the High Street, past Bennett's Fine Wines and Campden Gallery. Take the first right up Church Street, past the Eight Bells pub on your left. Keep left, past the almshouses with St James Church on your right. Go straight on up 'no entry' road and the footpath entrance is at end of the row of cottages.
- 2 Follow footpath across school drive and through the iron gate. The path eventually opens out into a field. Keep the hedge on your left. Bear right at telegraph pole.
- 3 At the bottom of the field, go through the gate at the left end of the wood and over the railway tunnel. Head to the left of Mickleton Hills Farmhouse and up the tree-lined drive.

- 4 Turn left at the road and walk for a short way until you see the footpath signposted left. Follow path through field and over a small bridge. Path then heads up hill towards farm buildings and Wold's End Farm. Head across the yard and follow sign beside barn and through kissing gate. Footpath is straight ahead of you. Bear right after gate and retrace your steps past Campden School. As you get back to the road, bear right down Cider Mill Lane, and left onto the High Street. Edward 'China' Wilson's garden is on your left and worth a visit.

Walk 2 Blue - 2.5 miles 1 hour (Some of the route is up hill.)

- 1 START With the Noel Arms on your left, head down the High Street with the Robert Welch shop on your left. Turn right at St Catherine's Church. Follow the signposted route up hill.
- 2 At the road, turn left for 250m, then cross over and take the footpath across the field to your right which brings you out onto Dover's Hill, site of the famous Cotswold Olympics.
- 3 Turn left and follow the escarpment to the Topograph which shows you the points of interest on this amazing view.
- 4 Walk through the car park behind you, turn left then left again at the road. There is a footpath downhill across a field to your right. Pass through an old orchard, between houses then zig zag back to Hoo Lane and the High Street.

Walk 3 Red - 2.5 miles 1 hour (Sturdy boots. Some gentle uphill walking.)

- 1 Go under the archway beside the Noel Arms, across the car park, up the road and straight ahead up the path, with the recreation ground on your right. When you meet the road, take the footpath signposted on your left which runs inside the hedge and then up the field.
- 2 At the bottom of the path go through the gateway and in front of Maidenwell Manor. Keep to the bark path as you cross the driveway and go through the gate. Pass the Quaker Meeting House on your left - established in 1663 and the oldest in the country - and turn left after the church down a narrow road.
- 3 After 200yds, as the road climbs slightly, turn sharp left up the driveway at Hollybush. Go through the gate at the end and, keeping the fence on your left, walk through the orchard to the gate at the bottom. As you enter the field, turn right, keeping the stream on your right, and walk through two fields, bearing left at the second field boundary. Look behind you at the lovely views! Bear left then left again after the gate and, keeping the farmhouse on your left, walk between the paddocks to the kissing gate. After three kissing gates you meet the River Cam.
- 4 Follow the river on your right, past the ruined Lady Juliana's Gateway and at the top corner go through the gate. Follow the path through the houses then turn right back down into the Noel Arms car park.
